For the past few years we have held a used instrument sale which has been very successful. We are anticipating doing it again this year, so . . .

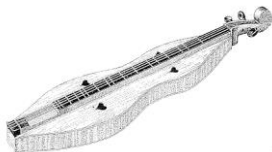


If you would be interested in bringing one or more instruments (of any kind, not just dulcimers, up to a maximum of five, please) to offer for sale at the festival,
