Rentals:

We will have rental dulcimers available for those who need them. If you would like to rent a dulcimer, please let us know ahead of time so that we can make sure there will be a dulcimer for you.

T-Shirts and Briefcases:

T-shirts will be navy blue this year, 100% cotton (medium weight) printed in light blue with the 2010 logo. Short-sleeved T-shirt will have a full size logo on the front of the shirt; long-sleeved mock turtleneck shirt will have a smaller logo on the left chest.
